LIBRARY

The library is an extension and continuation of student's classrooms. All students, Pre-K to 8th Grade, attend Library class once a week. During their time in the library, students learn basic rules and procedures of the library and literature appreciation where recreational reading is encouraged. They learn age-appropriate strategies needed to access and evaluate information that is used in collaboration with classroom assignments. Pre-K to 5th Grade students enjoy listening to books read aloud in the amphitheater and completing an activity to review elements of that book. While Middle School students participate in D.E.A.R (Drop Everything and Read), Kahoots, Quizizz and work on research projects.
