DURING THEIR TIME, STUDENTS LEARN BASIC RULES AND PROCEDURES OF THE LIBRARY AS WELL AS LITERATURE APPRECIATION, WHERE RECREATIONAL READING IS ENCOURAGED. THEY LEARN AGE-APPROPRIATE STRATEGIES NEEDED TO ACCESS AND EVALUATE INFORMATION THAT IS USED IN COLLABORATION WITH CLASSROOM ASSIGNMENTS. PRE-K TO 5TH GRADE STUDENTS ENJOY LISTENING TO BOOKS, READ ALOUD IN THE AMPITHEATER AND COMPLETING AN ACTIVITY TO REVIEW ELEMENTS OF THAT BOOK. MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS PARTICIPATE IN ACTIVITIES AND PROJECTS THAT DEVELOP STRATEGIES TO LOCATE AND EVALUATE IN PRINT MEDIA AND ELECTRONIC SOURCES, AS WELL AS ENHANCE AN UNDERSTANDING OF LITERATURE WORKS AND RULES OF WRITING.
