Our Classroom

The main focus of our room is to prepare your child for their kindergarten year. We emphasize the basics of learning colors, numbers, letters and shapes. We practice skills like handwriting and reading while also focusing on classroom behaviors such as following rules and directions. We encourage independence in the classroom and let children explore



HANDWRITING: CHILDREN WORK ON IDENTIFYING UPPER/LOWER CASE LETTERS, LETTER SOUNDS, TRACING AND FREE WRITING.
DOLCH SIGHT WORDS: BOTH INDIVIDUALLY AND AS A CLASS WE WORK ON A GOAL OF 100 SIGHT WORDS THAT ARE BROKEN DOWN INTO GROUPS OF 10 THROUGHOUT THE YEAR. THE OBJECTIVE IS TO MASTER EACH SET OF WORDS.

SHOW & TELL: ONCE A WEEK CHILDREN PRESENT THEIR OBJECTS REPRESENTING THE 'LETTER OF THE WEEK.'

ASSESSMENTS: ASSESSMENTS ARE PREFORMED 3 TIMES A YEAR FOR COLORS, SHAPES, LETTERS, NUMBERS (1-20), COUNTING, PHONICS AND THE HANDLING AND USE OF A PENCIL.
